ABSENTEE VOTING & VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINES

Absentee Ballots for the Sept. 13, 2011 School Election are available in the Monroe County Auditor's Office. Voters wishing to vote absentee in the Albia Community School District **and** the Eddyville-Blakesburg Community School District may do so in person in the Auditor's Office Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. **or** voters may request an absentee ballot be mailed to their residence.

Absentee request forms may be found on the Iowa Secretary of State's website www.sos.state.ia.us, Monroe County's Website www.monroecoia.us under County Forms/Auditor Forms or you may pick up a request form or request one from the Auditor's Office – 10 Benton Ave. E, Albia, IA 52531 ph. 641-932-2865.

You may also send a handwritten request with the following information:

Voters Name, Driver's License Number or last 4 digits of Social Security Number, Birthdate, Registered Address, Mailing Address (if different than registered address), Name and Date of Election. **(School Election – Sept. 13, 2011)**

The request **must be signed and dated by the voter requesting the ballot.** Mail requests or hand deliver them to the office of: Monroe Co. Auditor, 10 Benton Ave. East, Albia, IA 52531.

- **Deadline to request Absentee Ballot by mail is Fri., Sept. 9, 2011 – 5:00 p.m.**
- **Absentee Ballots must be postmarked no later than Sept. 12, 2011 and received before the Canvass on Sept. 16, 2011**
- **Deadline to vote Absentee in- person is Monday, Sept. 12, 2011 – 5:00 p.m. for Eddyville-Blakesburg Schools and Tuesday, Sept. 13, 2011 – 11:00 a.m. for Albia Community Schools**

Voter pre-registration deadlines for the School Election are:

- **Friday, Sept. 2, 2011 - 5:00 p.m.**
- **Registration forms which are postmarked on or before August 29, 2011 are considered on time for the School Election, even if they are received after 5 p.m. on September 2, 2011.**
